Notes from the Week

Reading

We reviewed the phonics concepts we have been learning over the past weeks: consonant blends and suffixes. Students read words to me individually and took a spelling assessment. Next week, we will begin learning about long vowel words with a silent e at the end of the word.

Math

Students continue to practice math facts to build automaticity and accuracy. We learned about 3D shapes this week and what they look like in real life. Students learned about spheres, cubes, rectangular prisms, cones, cylinders, and pyramids.

Religion

Each day, we put up an ornament on our Jesse Tree and read about a figure in the Bible who came before Jesus. This week, we learned about the Old Testament Joseph, Moses, David, the prophets, and John the Baptist. We watched a video about Our Lady of Guadalupe on her feast day and learned about St. Monica and the virtue of patience.

Science/Social Studies
