

### Notes from the Week

#### Reading

#### Math

This week, we worked on subtraction within 20 and solved some real world addition and subtraction problems. We will continue to work on our math facts as we begin learning about graphs next week.

#### Religion

Students learned about St. Teresa of Avila and the virtue of temperance. We talked about how temperance is only having a healthy amount of something good. We are preparing to host Mass next week and are also learning about the Last Supper and Stations of the Cross.

#### Science/Social Studies
