Notes from the Week

Reading

This week, students began learning words with the ee vowel digraph (tree, sleep, meet). We read a Frog and Toad story and talked about what seeds need to grow. Students wrote about the characters, setting, and plot in the story.

Math

This week, students learned about how to add 2-digit numbers. We first used place value blocks and then moved on to adding numbers on paper. They were taught to always add the ones place first before adding the tens place. This will be essential when we move on to addition with regrouping.

Religion

We talked about the Annunciation on Monday and learned about our virtue of the month-- obedience. Students heard the story about Jesus ascending to Heaven after He spent 40 days teaching and being with His disciples after He rose from the dead.

Science/Social Studies

Students wrote their addresses and drew a picture of their home. They learned that this is their absolute location. We talked about landforms and bodies of water, and students made landforms out of Play-Doh. We investigated materials that allow no light, some light, or all light to pass through them.
