Notes from the Week

Reading

We finished our review of letter sounds, sight words, handwriting formation, and basic reading words that students learned in kindergarten. Math

This week we worked on telling stories using addition and writing addition equations to fit pictures. Students have been working hard and have been doing a great job with these skills!
